Clarion Call - England

Rev. Jennifer Wallace opened the

meeting with a call to repentance on behalf of Church and Nation. We cried out to God in repentance on our knees and faces. As we sought His forgiveness, the women wept and wept. The scriptures and songs fitted so well together you knew the Holy Spirit had initiated them

As we sang Graham Kendrick's Song, 'O Lord the Clouds are Gathering,' we cried out: "Have mercy Lord, Forgive us, Lord! Restore us, Lord! Revive your church again!"

Ann Dunn led the clarion call to women in the UK with prayers and shouts of AWAKE! ARISE! from fear, complacency, apathy and indifference! AWAKE! ARISE! to stand, pray and contend for the nation – our families, communities, villages, towns and cities. We did a prophetic act by moving from where we were each standing, and marching towards the north, south,

east and west, in response to the call. As we prayed I knew that the call will reverberate throughout the UK, and women would arise and 'march' to the north, south, east and west, praying and proclaiming Jesus! We look forward to the manifestation of this. Praise God!

We prayed for revival in the Church in the UK, a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit, bringing people to the knowledge and revelation of Jesus. We prayed for unity and oneness in the Church. It was a wonderful, awesome time and great to see women from different denominations coming together to pray and intercede in oneness for the Church and the UK.

We give God thanks for His Grace, His Mercy and everlasting faithfulness. Thank God for the QUIVER prayer initiative to bring this Nation back to God. We continue to pray that the nation will return to God and submit to His Word and will. ♦

CLARION CALL - WALES

On Saturday 23 February we gathered in response to the clarion call to fast and pray for Wales and the UK. We were a small number but Jesus was there. We also sensed that we were linked with Quiver England and to those Quiver Wales ladies who pray on their own.

Ann Davies led us into prayer by sharing the meaning and the response to the sounding of the shofar. It was a surprising insight and connected with our prayer focus.

- ♦ *Tekiah* which is the wake-up call - get on with it, get your lives lined up with His will for you.
- ♦ The three-blasts of *Shevarim* to remind of brokenness of mankind by sin.
- ♦ Then *Teruah* which is the sobbing of repentance

and the longing of the heart to return to the Father.

After we proclaimed this we went into a period of repentance that was personally challenging. It was also heart-breaking to reflect how far the nation has drifted from its true perspective of our Maker and the Almighty God has been brought down to our smallness. We ended with the final long note of the shofar (*Tekiah Gedolah*) that brings hope of continuing redemption and salvation. The note of this *Tekiah Gedolah*, a single unbroken *blast*, will grow louder and stronger and clearer until the Lord Jesus returns.

The Lord then spoke clearly out of I Peter 4:7-11. (*This is paraphrased*) The end of all things is near so be clear minded and self-controlled so that you can pray. Love each other, use your gifts for each other, administer God's grace in its various forms, speak the very words of God and do all in His strength - so that God may be praised through Jesus. May this overflow in the Quiver ladies. ♦

QN Interview

Quiver News (QN) speaking to Jaleesa (J) and Sarah, (S) University students, who attended the QUIVER Clarion Call prayer and fasting meeting in London on 23 Feb 2013



QN: How did you find today's meeting?

S: It was brilliant. You know it's one of the things you know that God has put on your heart to pray about, and although we knew about Quiver before, it was probably in the last few weeks that we've been drawn to pray for the UK. I have been touched by today; even the verse I was given to read, God gave me that verse for Quiver and I have been praying it.

J: God has put it on my heart to pray for revival in the UK - the scriptures I was given to read today both were on revival! Powerful! It's exciting to see what God is doing.

QN: There were four key areas of Prayer: Which of those were your focus?
