LAUNCHING QUIVER

Saturday, 1 October 2011 saw the launch of QUIVER at The Cornerstone Church in Leyton, London. This was in the form of a breakfast meeting attended by women from all across London. In attendance were a group of enthusiastic women who share a common purpose - a passion to pray for revival in this nation. They came together to learn about QUIVER and how they can actively start a QUIVER group in their area.

"A quiver is a case full of arrows. An arrow in a quiver is a strategy or option that could be used to achieve an objective" – Dictionary.com

Thus, QUIVER, simply defined, is small groups of women praying together for revival. Each group or "QUIVER" ideally consists of five focused women, fervently and ardently

praying to God for revival in the UK. These prayerful women will be "arrows" in God's hands to fulfill His purposes in the land.

QUIVER's inception came about through a personal revelation given by God to Rev Jennifer Wallace, founder of WOMEN IN TUNE (more information WOMEN IN TUNE can be found at www.womenintune.org). In the encounter, the Lord instructed Rev Jennifer to "gather women in the UK to pray for revival." The strategy given was to get the women to form small prayer groups of up to five women in every county, village, town and city in the UK.

The launch commenced with a time of worship through song followed by introductions. The women

shared how they heard about QUIVER which was through various sources including a live interview with Rev Jennifer Wallace and Maria Rodriguez-Toth on Premier Radio, Premier Gospel's Blog page and word of mouth.

Rev Wallace spoke of the significance of the day. She said God had opened a book of remembrance on this day, a day in which He renewed our strength. She also shared the vision of QUIVER and what she perceived the Lord is about to do in the UK. After that there was group discussion to identify what hinders women from rising to the call to prayer, and also how we can get more women to get involved with the vision of QUIVER.

Rev Wallace encouraged us to know, as women in Christ, that what endorses and empowers us is bigger than what hinders us. These were things such as the gender issues within the Body of Christ, fear,


