## Why Women?

There have been numerous prophecies that women will be at the helm of the prayer movement to bring revival again to this land – a revival that would spread to Europe and beyond. Most of these prophecies have been ignored by the Church but it appears that God is moving to bring them to fulfillment. But, why women? What about our gender qualifies us for such an awesome task? Here's the answer.

There is a common language that all women know. It transcends culture, social status, language, background – it is the language of reproduction, birthing and nurturing. Women have been fearfully and wonderfully made in the image of God to recreate, reproduce and nurture life. (*Gen 1:26; Rom 1:20*).

- ◆ A woman is designed to receive. A woman will receive and take anything – a male seed, love or hatred, a prayer need or request. It does not

matter what it is, so long as a woman receives it, it becomes seed in her, with a full potential to germinate and bear fruit.

- ◆ A woman multiplies what she has received. Whatever a woman receives she multiplies. Give her a vision, a business idea or a prayer burden. Once she receives it as seed, she will take it into her spiritual womb, incubate and multiply and carry it.
- ◆ A woman births what she has received, multiplied and carried. The strength of birthing is one of the most powerful natural human forces existing.
- ◆ A woman nurtures and raises what she has birthed.
- ◆ Women have strength to endure. They endure length of pregnancy with its associated problems, knowing that 'though it tarries it shall surely come'

All these qualities are necessary requirements for birthing and nurturing revival. This is why God is calling on women at this time, to arise, take on the prayer mandate and pray for revival in this nation.

Unfortunately, not every woman will heed the call and

arise, however, those women who will arise will possess the following characteristics: (*Isaiah 32:9-12*)

1. They will listen out for God's voice, in the midst of all that is happening around the.
2. They are troubled by what is going on around them. They have a burden concerning the church and land. Are troubled about how to bring the glory of God back.
3. They are willing to rise up and take responsibility for the situation in the land. We cannot do this if we do not take responsibility
4. They are willing to make the necessary sacrifices – stripping themselves of self, the flesh and personal comforts and needs.
5. They will come before God in brokenness, humility, repentance, fasting, prayer, intercession, supplication, wailing and travail, knowing that there is no help for the land but from God.
6. They are willing to go the long haul because they know and believe that whatever the burden, there will be a giving birth and revival will come.
