A DIFFERENT SEASON

Quiver Wales is in a different season. Last year there was a flurry of activity as interest in the Quiver vision grew. It be-



came a roller coaster ride with encouragements, then setbacks and finally the reality check. Many, who initially were fired by Quiver, just slipped away and support dwindled. It seemed as if hearts had looked for quick and easy answers. However, from the onset Father God had not promised this, and even on our first visit to the South Wales valleys a levelling prophecy was given. Its central theme was that spiritual transformation would come by breaking down rocks through constant knocking (praying) - it was not a promise of a **quick fix solution**.

A vivid example of the "breaking of rocks" can be seen on our coastline. The area is subject to erosion due to the movement of rocks and dangerous tides. Massive boulders were placed at the edge of Llantwit beach to solve this problem – these fixed rocks would be unmoveable. But the persistent and powerful crashing and smashing of the sea against these boulders has caused a shift. The "constant knocking" has now begun to splinter these hard rocks.

Hallelujah for that picture!

(Isaiah 51:11). Contending in prayer involves that same tenacity – it is unremitting, yearning intercession armed with His power. If we look on the outward, on the dire state of the nation, the deadness in our churches, our weak faith then we might say, "these rocks are too hard to break".

So Quiver Wales has a different and unexpected pattern emerging. So we are developing into small groups dotted around the land and often in isolated places. So our fellowship is by telephone, by e-mail and even writing letters! It is as He has planned it. Reflecting on Phil 2:13 the Greek word for "works" means giving energy to produce effect. Father God produces that enabling effect in us "both to will and to do"

Yes, we need spiritual muscles and spiritual energy to keep praying. We need faith to keep running with the vision. The LORD has been encouraging me with these words from Isaiah 52 "Awake, awake; put on your strength (His joy), O Zion; put on your beautiful garments (the garments of praise). REJOICE! Don't look at what you think is happening but look through spiritual eyes and see what I AM doing. Listen to My voice and not the many voices that seem to speak louder. Perceive **MY** heart. Wake up and praise and in this unity of praise strongholds will be demolished.

I believe this is how QUIVER will continue – praying, interceding, waiting, listening, trusting, believing and hoping, and not giving up until the rocks break. In Jesus Name. Amen \blacklozenge

PRAISE REPORT

The Lord had been stirring in our hearts since we attended our first QUIVER gathering last year. I knew that this was definitely on God's heart for us to start a



QUIVER group, I just didn't know how I was going to go about it as I was entering into my final year of my course but the Lord said to wait.

Then Jaleesa, who had invited me to the first QUIVER meeting, received a QUIVER letter in the post and felt God was talking to her through it. After reading the letter, Jaleesa felt led to leave it on one of the tables in the Christian Union in her University. She put the letter in her bag and went to Uni, but forgot about it. However, while having a conversation with a friend she saw the letter in her bag and innocently passed it to him. Her friend (who was the president of the Christian Union) told her he has released her to start a QUIVER group in the Christian Union and from then on Jaleesa felt empowered to run with the vision of QUIVER to bring Glory to the King of Kings.
