Recently, I had a meeting with the Uganda Country Rep of our ministry Women In Tune. She was in the UK

on a short visit and we got together to discuss our mission to Uganda next month.

God has opened a great door for us in Uganda and we now have access, with the backing of the leadership of the Body of Christ in Uganda, to disciple, equip and empower women to rise up and build the 'ruins' of their homes, families, communities and nation, through the Gospel of Jesus Christ

As we talked, I remembered the prophecies I had received within the past 10 years concerning the work the Lord would use us to do in Uganda. God had given a picture of revival, a vision of a New, True, and Christ-centred Church emerging from the pain and brokenness of the people. The vision given was of the Bride of Christ, beautiful, clad in her bridal garments and prevailing and triumphing over the gates of hell until a new nation emerged. God had also made it clear that this would only happen through the empowering of both His Spirit and His Word.

In 2009, we embarked on our first mission to Uganda. Four years later, to the praise and glory of God, a solid foundation has been laid for Him to fulfil His vision. It has taken much

My Experience With QUIVER By Ann Dunn (QUIVER London)

renda and I arrived at the Cornerstone Church on Saturday 6th July for the QUIVER Prayer Breakfast and thought; "It's a bit quiet here!"



Then I suddenly realised that the venue was not here today but at Shernhall Methodist; I hope no-one else was caught out in this way.

We had a lovely continental breakfast and fellowship with one another. There were ten of us to start with. The programme started with praise and worship. Rev Jennifer then brought us a word based on Hebrews 6:1, which says, "Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection ... " She encouraged us to come up in our knowledge of Jesus Christ and went on to speak about what it meant lesus being King of Kings and Lord of Lord - He is the great Potentate of the universe. This emphasises the solitary nature of Jesus Christ's dominion, rule and power over the all creation, the earth and the nations. (1 Tim 6:15; Rev 17:14; Rev 9:16)

Rev Jennifer then looked at Psalms 24 and particularly at the **gates** (our gates are the gates of culture – language, family/marriage, government, socioeconomy, education, media/arts and religion). The **gates** ask the question "Which King" (Who is this King of Glory). Our response is the **Lord Almighty He is the King of Glory, El Gibbor, The Lord God our Hero.** The gates asked again, and our response is **the Lord of Host, Jehovah Sabaoth.** These are the war names of God, which the gates respond to.

Rev Jennifer used a beautiful example of the remote control and the TV and that God has put His remote in us, His authority, to which the gates must respond. In Wales QUIVER were told that it is with the constant knocking that the door opens. Rev Jennifer expounded on how we need to speak to situations, but it is not enough to speak, we cannot speak our own words, we need to be sitting in God's Counsel (Jer 23:18) and hearing what He is saying then speak what we hear being said; the angels respond to His words and work on our behalf to bring to pass what God has said. This is the kind of praying we need to be engaging in now.

We must also press in with worship and the word, knowing that what heaven has bound is what we are binding here on earth because we are merely praying into effect, *"Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done here on earth as it is in heaven."* We must, therefore, now leave the elementary things and come into maturity concerning the things of Christ, (Who He is, what He is about and who we are in Him), and the only way we are going to do this is by coming into His presence and waiting to hear from Him.

There was then a time of intercession in which I felt the strong presence of God, we all naturally went to our knees, some prostrated. This was followed by declarations being made by Rev Jennifer and worship naturally followed on.

More people joined us during the morning. We left with a sense of progress being made in the heavenlies. We now look to putting into effect what we learnt. We also look with eagerness to receive a copy of the recorded section of the day. \blacklozenge
